Hope's Corner serves a hot and nutritious meal every Saturday 8am-10am, Monday 8am-9am and Wednesday 8am-9am at the corner of Hope and Mercy in Mountain View.

#### And there was!

93 volunteers, donating 763 hours, made the December 17th, Hope's Corner Children's Holiday Event a joyous success for low-income and very low-income families in our community. 673 children received more than one gift and families were able to take home stocking stuffers, books and warm items such as hats, gloves and socks. Each family also received a bag of donated groceries as well as a \$25 grocery gift card. Thank you to all the elves who were able to lend their support in some way!

### What do the numbers tell us?

- In 2023, 38% of our guests at Hope's Corner reported being unhoused.
- 1,762 different people received food from Hope's Corner in 2023. 151 were under 18 years old, 768 adults, and 843 seniors.
- In 2023 a total of 43,528 meals were served. That's 837 meals a week!
