# ABOUT HOPE'S CORNER

- Hope's Corner, located at the corner of **Hope and Mercy Streets** in downtown Mountain View, has been providing hot nutritious meals every Saturday since 2011.
- We provide about **700 hot, nutritious meals** each week to hungry folks, including local RV residents and day workers at the Day Worker Center of Mountain View.
- Each week about **30 – 40 homeless individuals** use our 2 onsite handicap-accessible showers to improve their hygiene. We offer them new undergarments and socks.
- We provide **laundry services, refurbished bicycles** for transportation, and **bicycle accessories** (e.g., locks, lights, helmets) to unhoused individuals.
- In partnership with other organizations, businesses, and groups, our guests can get **free haircuts, flu shots, and medical checks** at different times during the year.
- Hope's Corner is a place of belonging, where **everyone is welcome** and no one is turned away. We offer our guests hope for a better future.
